## **Green spaces**

## **Architecture and conservation**

- Prue Chiles presentation 'Visions of Broomhill'
  will take place at the Broomhill Festival and will
  involve participation of those attending to gather
  ideas. Her photos and material will go on the
  BBEST website.
- School of Architecture will do a project on Broomhill. Several students will look at access to the retail district. They hope to work with a school and construct a model. This will produce ideas for a Design Guide. The students will make a public presentation at the end. Noted: need to inform shopkeepers that this is happening.

## Sustainable and balanced communities

- MW paper on this topic welcomed by SG.
- The paper noted that the area is loosely defined in the literature and the following suggestions were made in relation to the BBEST area:
  - Sustainability of the environment with too many rented properties.
  - Overpopulation of built environment
  - Housing: ensure that affordable housing available - a check on this is whether those working in the area can afford to live there. Concern that this is not the case in BBEST area.
  - Age balance. SG felt that population is polarised with many 18-24 and older groups. Census data is currently being analysed in this context.
- Noted proposal for Housing co-op for UoS students.

	<ul> <li>Noted that we need greater clarity on regulations relating to HMOs, e.g. Article 4 and CS41. PM to ask MW to do some work on this. For example rules about letting signs.</li> <li>We do not have information about levels of affordable housing in the BBEST area. There are few sites for development and so increasing the number might be difficult.</li> <li>Noted recent work by Ed Ferrari and Alasdair Rae of TRP.</li> <li>MW to check what other neighbourhood plans include about affordable housing – rental, shared ownership and owner occupied.</li> </ul>	PM
